

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (AAS)

Associate of Applied Science degrees are career technical in nature and are intended primarily to lead students directly to employment in a specific career. Occupational licensure, career advancement and further study at a four-year college or university are additional opportunities for students earning an AAS degree. Associate of Applied Science degrees are awarded to students who complete the requirements of a specified, two-year career and technical program and are offered in a number of interest areas (see [Degree Programs](#)).

Requirements

- Complete a minimum of 90 credits
- Establish a cumulative 2.0 GPA at CCC
- Establish residency by earning a minimum of 25% of the credits at CCC
- Complete one course from each of the [Related Instruction](#) areas
